

Fig. 88 (Rev. 06/13) (New 02/60)

## **Notes and Additional Requirements:**

- 1. Load weight must be evenly distributed end to end and side to side.
- 2. For very dense products like iron ore, the preponderance of load must be concentrated over the trucks, with the remainder distributed between as shown in drawings.
- 3. Product weighing more than 175 lb/ft<sub>3</sub> loaded in cross hoppers must have the hopper doors secured in accordance with Fig. 89 of this section.
