CSX Operations in Alabama


- Operates and maintains nearly 1,500 miles of track*
- Maintains more than 940 public and private grade crossings
- Handled nearly 1.6 million carloads of freight on the state's rail network
- At the end of 2015, CSX employed nearly 1,250 people
- Throughout 2015, CSX reported more than \$129 million in compensation for employees**
- In 2015, CSX invested nearly \$113.8 million in its Alabama network. In addition, the company invested more than \$1 billion in freight cars and other rolling assets to serve customers throughout its rail system.
- CSX carries a variety of commodities important to our economy and way
 of life, including consumer products, automobiles, food and agriculture
 products, and coal. Major commodities produced or consumed within
 the state include coal, containerized consumer goods, aggregates,
 passenger vehicles, and packaging paper.

CSX and the Alabama Community

- In partnership with state and local economic development agencies, Alabama businesses invested more than \$117 million in new or expanded rail-served facilities on CSX or its connecting regional and short lines in 2015. These investments will generate more than 180 new jobs at those businesses.
- CSX has designated the Macon County I-85 Site in Tuskegee and Notasulga and the Wasden Road I-65 Site in Montgomery as "Select Sites," rail-served, ready-to-build locations for industrial development and expansion. The "Select Site" program is part of CSX's network-wide economic development initiative.
- In 2015, CSX contributed more than \$92,000 to organizations in Alabama, including JDRF, Christmas for Kids, Alabama Operation Lifesaver, and Freshwater Land Trust.
