Set Cancellation

Functional Group=AL

Purpose: This X12 Transaction Set contains the format and establishes the data contents of the Set Cancellation Transaction Set (998) for use within the context of an Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) environment. The transaction set can be used to request the deletion of a previously transmitted transaction set and will indicate the reason for this action, such as diversion or cancelled bill.

Notes:

1/0100 998s received after a unit has ingated will not be processed. An 824 will be sent to the sender of a 998 stating whether the void was processed or not. If you company cannot process an 824, the 824 can be converted to an email and sent to the address you identify.

Accepting the 824 or email equivalent is required for all 998 senders.

Semantics:

1. The transaction set identifier (ST01) is used by the translation routines of the interchange partners to select the appropriate transaction set definition (e.g., 810 selects the Invoice Transaction Set).
2. The implementation convention reference (ST03) is used by the translation routines of the interchange partners to select the appropriate implementation convention to match the transaction set definition. When used, this implementation convention reference takes precedence over the implementation reference specified in the GS08.
